Reviews of current INDEX data has been completed for HEIs for nearly all NMs. There is a delay in the schedule for the Programme checking: only a few NMs have received the instructions from the IT developer so far. This will be done in the coming weeks. <br> Mrs. G. SCHACHINGER stated that AT has not been able to start the work for HEI checking and would require an interface for this. Mr D. CLARK informed that while HEI checking of the UK has been made, an interface would be required for a onetime transfer of programmes.
